The programme takes place on the beautiful University of Chichester Bognor Regis campus and is designed specifically for international HND and Dazhuan students who plan to start a top up degree in 2016. Over the four week programme

- You will improve your Academic English
- You will learn university academic study skills
- You will become more confident
- You will experience UK university life and culture



Taught in small groups (no more than 12 students per group) you will learn academic skills needed to complete your HND/Dazhuan and then confidently complete a UK university degree programmes.

The summer language course covers:

- Academic writing, reading, listening and note taking
- Preparing and delivering presentations
- Critical study and research skills
- Essential academic rules
- Writing extended essays

You will experience:

- A safe, welcoming environment on the south coast of England
- A full-time programme of 18 hours class time plus 4 hours guided self and group study per week
- Highly experienced and qualified university tutors
- Individual support including one to one tutorials
- Introduction to current UK study methods
- Full access to all university facilities – library, IT and multi-media
- languages study area
- Working at UK University level
- Academic life and culture at the University





How will I study?

You will study 18 hours per week in a class room PLUS at least 5 hours of either guided group work, individual tutorials or assessments. For each hour in class you will need to study / practice for 1 additional hour. Classes run from Monday to Friday and you must attend all sessions.
